



QUARTERLY ACTIVITIES REPORT

For the Quarter Ended 30 June 2026

Highlights:

- Bison Resources commenced trading on the ASX following a heavily oversubscribed IPO that raised A\$5.5 million.
- Experienced mining professional, Tim Mackellar, appointed as Chief Executive Officer to lead Bison's next phase of growth and exploration.
- Maiden field program underway comprising geological mapping, rock chip and soil geochemical sampling across all four Projects – targeting carbonate-hosted precious metal deposits.
- Promising assay results received for the first 66 rock chip and float samples collected at the Bald Peaks Project, defining a 1.5km-strike arsenic-antimony geochemical anomaly with a strong pathfinder elemental association (As-Sb +/- W-Hg-Tl) indicative of a potential Carlin-type mineral system.
- Mapping, rock chip and soil sampling is ongoing across the Projects, with the Company aiming to define anomalies for drill testing for mineralisation later this year.

Bison Resources Limited (ASX Code: “BSR”) (“Bison Resources” or “the Company”) is pleased to provide its Quarterly Activities Report for the period ending 30 June 2026 (“the Quarter”).

Bison Resources CEO, Tim Mackellar said:

“This has been an important first quarter for Bison Resources - from our ASX listing through to mobilising field crews across all four Nevada Projects. The results at Bald Peaks were particularly pleasing, with strong arsenic-antimony pathfinder anomalism indicative of a Carlin-type mineral system. With our airborne geophysics survey now underway across the portfolio, we're well placed to generate high-quality drill targets ahead of our maiden drill program.”

Bison Resources Overview

The Company's Nevada Projects – Bald Peaks, Ruby Lake, Cherry Springs and Medicine Range – collectively comprise 312 unpatented lode mining claims covering approximately 26.1 km², situated



approximately 80 km southeast of the city of Elko within the prolific Carlin Trend. The Carlin Trend is a world-class gold district, and the Company is targeting carbonate-hosted precious metal deposits sharing similar geology and structural settings to major gold-silver deposits in the region.

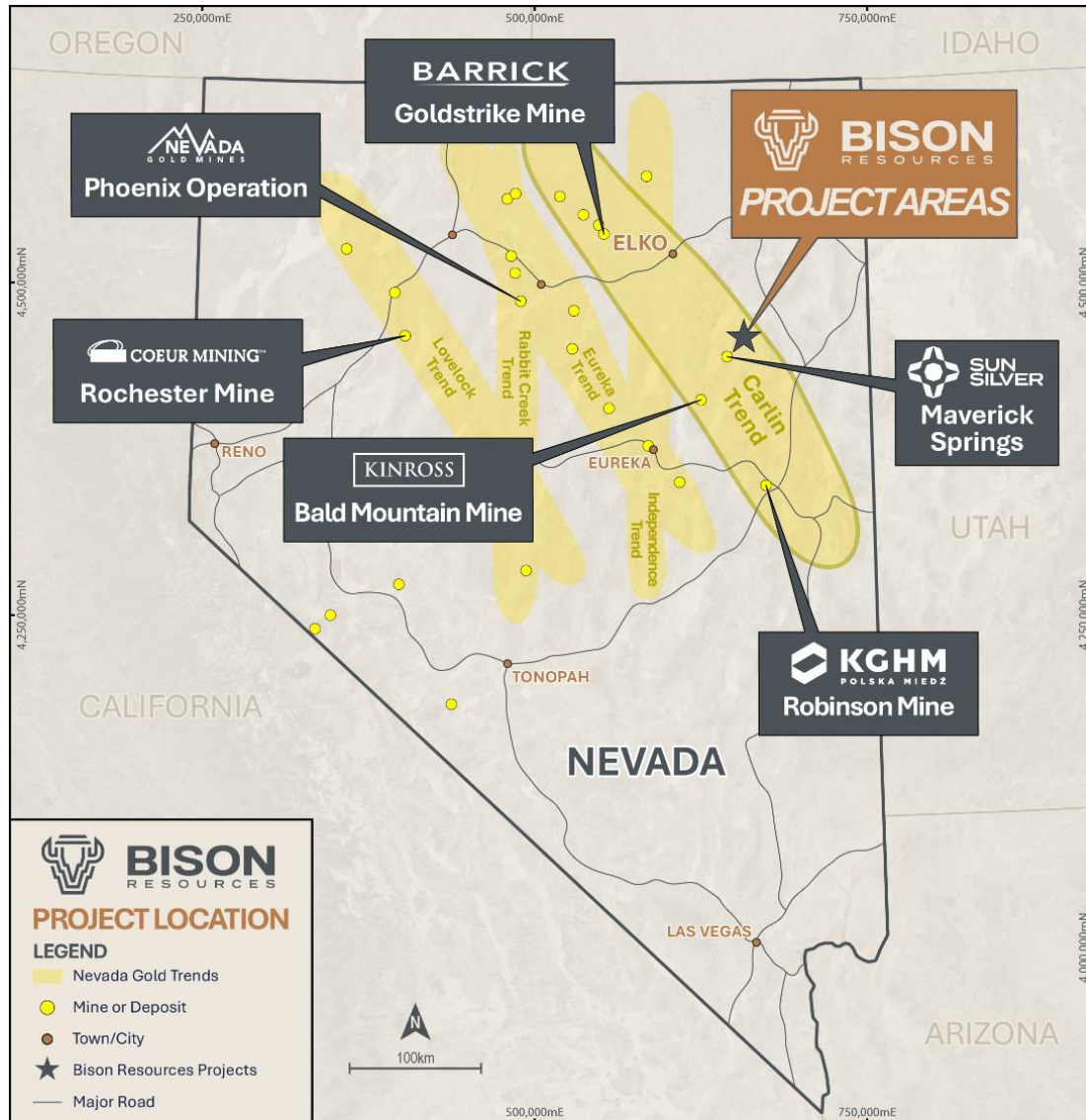


Figure 1: Location of the Bison Projects in relation to major Projects in Nevada.

The Company's Bald Peaks Project is located directly adjacent to Torex Gold Resources Inc.'s (TSX: TXG) high-grade Medicine Springs silver Project, and proximal to Sun Silver's (ASX: SS1) 539Moz AgEq Maverick Silver Project¹ (Figure 1). The Bald Peaks Project is similar in geological and structural setting to the Maverick Silver Project.

Commencement of Exploration Activities

During the Quarter, the Company commenced its initial exploration work program across its portfolio of four Projects in Elko County, northeast Nevada, USA.

The work program represents the Company's first field program following its recent ASX listing, and encompasses reconnaissance geological mapping, rock chip geochemical sampling and soil geochemical sampling across the Project portfolio.

Across all four Projects, the current program aims to:

- Conduct reconnaissance geological mapping to delineate outcropping lithologies and validate remote sensing targeting criteria.
- Collect rock chip geochemical samples from key spectral and structural targets.
- Establish Project-wide baseline soil geochemical datasets to refine and prioritise targets.
- Generate drill targets to underpin future maiden drill programs at priority prospects.

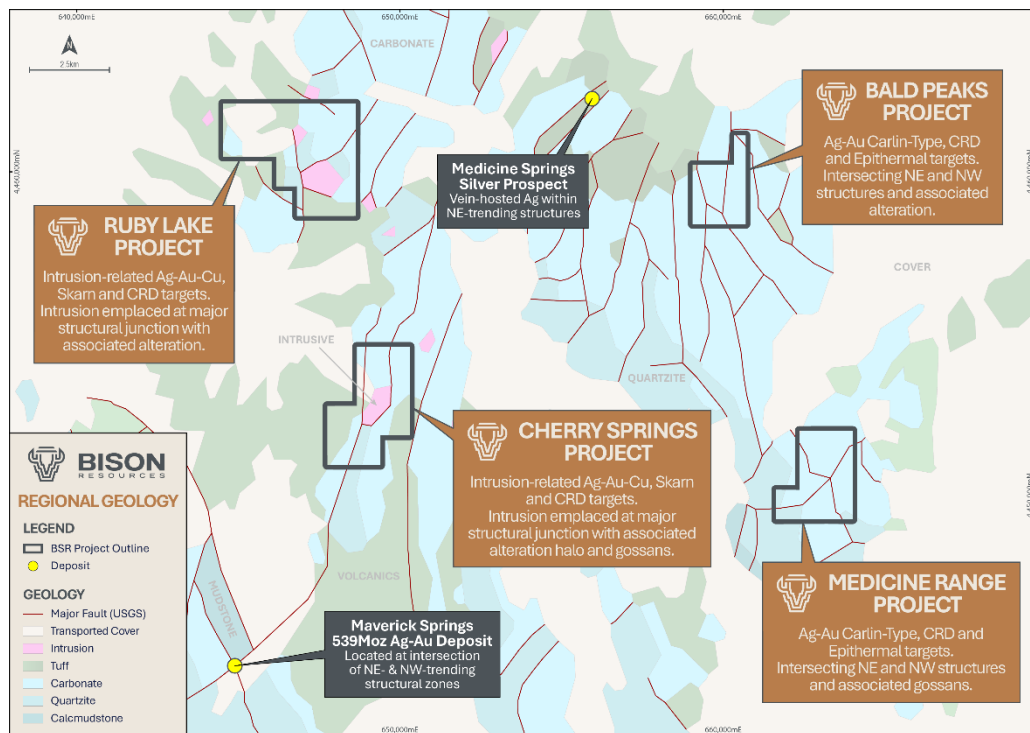


Figure 2: Overview of the Bison Projects underlain by the geological settings (500k USGS Bedrock Geology).

Across all four Projects, field activities will focus on validating hyperspectral anomalies² through rock chip sampling, as well as delineating surface geochemical anomalism through Project-wide soil sampling.

- **Bald Peaks Project** (40 claims, ~3.3 km²): Two significant spectral anomalies along the eastern

north-trending fault, including an 800 m kaolinite-jarosite anomaly to the north and a 1 km goethite-haematite anomaly to the south. These anomalies are considered prospective for epithermal and carbonate replacement-style precious metal deposits. The strong pathfinder elemental association (As-Sb +/- W-Hg-Tl) and alteration styles observed in the field during initial reconnaissance sampling³ are indicative of a potential Carlin-type mineral system at the Project. A 1.5km-strike arsenic-antimony geochemical anomaly is associated with decalcification of host carbonates, silicification, gossanous breccias and jasperoidal alteration.

- **Ruby Lake Project** (128 claims, ~10.7 km²): Remote sensing has identified a cluster of kaolinite, goethite and haematite spectral anomalies around the intersection of north and northeast-trending faults adjacent to the "Ruby Stock" intrusion.
- **Cherry Springs Project** (82 claims, ~6.9 km²): Two key target areas have been identified via remote sensing: kaolinite and haematite signatures at the margins of the "Cherry Stock" intrusion, and a 500 m x 500 m goethite-haematite spectral anomaly along the southern northeast-trending fault, considered potentially indicative of hydrothermal-style precious metal mineralisation.
- **Medicine Range Project** (62 claims, ~5.2 km²): An analogous litho-structural setting to the nearby Maverick Springs silver deposit, where a key lithological contact is dissected by a northeast and northwest-trending structural corridor, presenting a prime target for initial field validation through geological mapping, rock chip and soil geochemical sampling.

Bald Peaks – Carlin System Pathfinders Identified

Subsequent to the end of the Quarter, the Company announced the initial results from reconnaissance sampling at the Bald Peaks Project with assays received for 66 rock chip and float samples taken from the spectral target zones at the Bald Peaks Project³.

Two primary targets were previously defined at the Bald Peaks Project, associated with north- and northeast-trending brittle structures, including an 800m-long kaolinite-jarosite anomaly in the northeast and a 1km-long iron-rich anomaly in the south, interpreted to reflect potential significant hydrothermal fluid movement.

As part of the initial reconnaissance sampling, the field team visited key spectral anomalies to collect rock chip samples from in-situ material, and float samples, where outcrop could not be found, to determine the alteration style associated with each of the spectral anomalies.

The presence of strong arsenic-antimony anomalism, coupled with moderate intensity silica-alteration and decalcification at the Bald Peaks Project indicates that sampling to date has identified a proximal halo to a Carlin-type hydrothermal system and suggests the core of the mineralising system is yet to be revealed.

- Carlin-type gold deposits are amongst the world's largest gold systems.
- They are typically recognised during exploration by broad halos of pathfinder elements including proximal arsenic-antimony anomalism and distal mercury-thallium anomalism, which commonly extend beyond the gold mineralisation itself, reflecting the widespread nature of the causational

hydrothermal system.

- Anomalous pathfinder element geochemistry is an important indicator of fertility during the early stages of exploration.

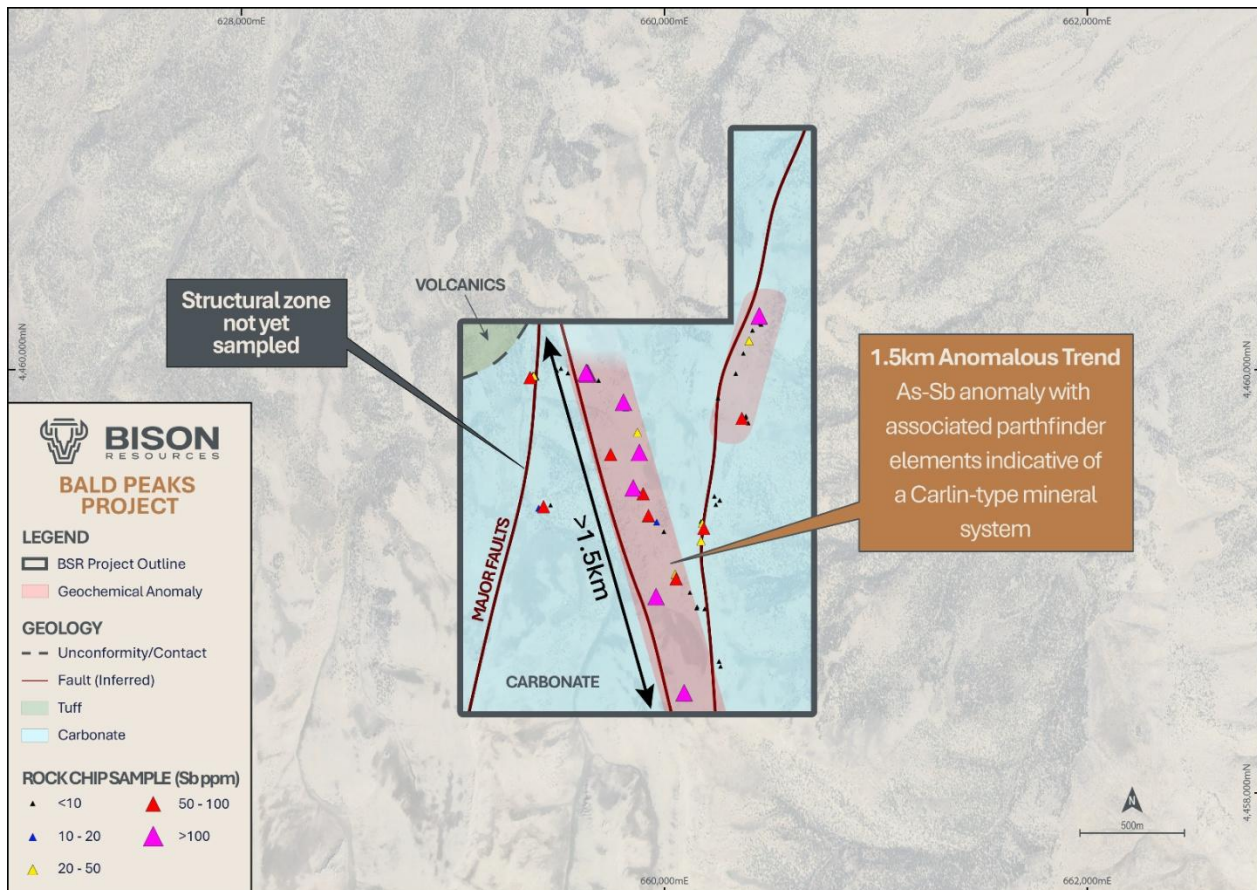


Figure 3: Topographic map of the Bald Peaks Project showing surface sample locations coded by Sb ppm in relation to lithologies and structures⁴.

The initial fieldwork has validated the Company's targeting model, with observed geochemical anomalism correlating closely with vectors defined through initial hyperspectral mapping of jarosite, hematite, goethite and kaolinite, together with zones of local decalcification, that were interpreted as being indicative of hydrothermal alteration of carbonates.

- Geochemical anomalism at the Bald Peaks Project is hosted by brecciated calcarenite, gossanous carbonates and jasperoidal cherts.
- Gossanous material is mappable at surface both in outcrop and float along the same trend as the geochemical anomalism and is closely related to a major interpreted brittle structure (Figure 3).
- Float samples are interpreted as being close to origin due to the steep topography, lack of active alluvial systems at the project, and presence of gossanous material along ridgelines.

Building on these initial results, the Company plans to advance a systematic soil sampling program with multi-element analysis to delineate pathfinder anomalies for follow-up detailed mapping and rock chip sampling.

This will be complemented by additional rock chip sampling and detailed geological mapping along the identified key geochemical trends to better define alteration zonation and pathfinder element dispersion patterns to refine and prioritise drill-targets.

In addition, airborne magnetic and ground gravity geophysical surveys are underway and planned to assist in delineating structural controls on mineralisation ahead of future drill testing.

Airborne Geophysical Survey

Subsequent to the end of the Quarter, the Company commenced an airborne geophysical survey across its portfolio of four projects in Elko County, northeast Nevada, USA.

The airborne geophysical survey will comprise of magnetic and radiometric surveying, flying at 100m spaced E-W lines over 4,112 line-kilometres. This represents a high-resolution survey – first of its kind in the area – that will enhance the Company’s exploration targeting, structural and geological interpretation of all project areas, that will inform future drill targeting.

Across all four projects, the current program aims to:

- Complete high-resolution magnetic and radiometric airborne survey over the wider project area.
- Assist in geological interpretation, structural understanding, and exploration targeting across all four projects.
- Assist generation of a pipeline of targets to inform future maiden drill programs at priority prospects.

Corporate

The Company commenced trading on the Australian Securities Exchange (“**ASX**”) on Thursday, 16 April 2026, following the successful completion of a heavily oversubscribed A\$5.5 million Initial Public Offering.

On 2 June 2026, the Company announced the appointment of Tim Mackellar as Chief Executive Officer. Tim is an experienced mining and resources professional with deep expertise in commercial strategy and execution of large-scale resource developments, spanning the full project lifecycle from concept and construction through to steady state operations across domestic and international jurisdictions. Tim has held senior commercial roles with leading global mining companies Rio Tinto and Fortescue, where he led and executed complex project agreements and transactions across multi-billion-dollar resource developments including Robe Valley, Winu and Kangwinan. His professional background also encompasses corporate and capital markets law, having practised at Steinepreis Paganin advising ASX-listed and emerging companies across the mining, resources and technology sectors on IPOs, equity raisings, corporate governance and listed-company transactions.

Finance

The Company's Quarterly cashflow report for the period ending 30 June 2026 is appended to this announcement ("**Appendix 5B quarterly cashflow report**").

The Company held cash reserves of ~A\$5.027 million at 30 June 2026.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 5.3.1, payments for exploration activities during the Quarter totalled A\$300k (item 1.2(a) of the Appendix 5B). Details of exploration activities undertaken during the Quarter are provided above.

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 5.3.2, the Company confirms that there were no mining production and development activities undertaken during the Quarter.
