



COMPLETION OF TRANCHE 1 PLACEMENT AND CLEANSING NOTICE

The Board of Critica Limited (ASX: CRI) (Company or Critica) refers to its announcement on Monday 17 November 2025 in respect of an \$8m two-tranche placement (Placement) to accelerate operational activities at the Company's flagship Jupiter rare earths project.

The Company confirms it has today completed Tranche 1 of the Placement through the issue of 203,062,884 fully paid ordinary shares in the Company at an issue price of \$0.026 per share (Placement Shares). In addition to the Placement a 1:1 free attaching option with a two-year expiry, exercisable at \$0.043 per share (Options) were issued totalling 203,062,884.

The Placement Shares and Options were issued using the Company's existing placement capacity under ASX Listing Rule 7.1.

Completion of the Tranche 2 Placement is subject to the Company obtaining shareholder approval to be sought at a General Meeting, which is presently anticipated to be held on or around Thursday, 15 January 2026. Pending shareholder approval, allotment of the Shares and under the Tranche 2 Placement and attaching Options is expected to occur on or around Wednesday, 21 January 2026.
