

WEST ARUNTA FIELDWORK SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED

KEY POINTS

- CuFe has completed its first pass on-ground field work at its exploration tenements in the West Arunta region, supported by Ngururrpa Traditional Owners
- Rock chip and soil samples collected have been submitted to laboratory for analysis
- Analysis of results (once received) and field observations will help to guide the future work program on the tenure including prioritising targets for a potential drilling program

CuFe Ltd (ASX: CUF) (**CuFe** or the **Company**) is pleased to advise completion of its first phase of fieldwork at its tenements (E80/5925, E80/5950, E80/5990 and E80/6052) in the West Arunta region of Western Australia.

The fieldwork was helicopter based and covered all four of CuFe's tenements in the region, with a focus on ground truthing of targets which had previously been identified by geophysical work (refer CUF ASX announcements dated 29 April 2024 and 18 July 2024), with rock chips and soil samples collected for analysis. The trip provided valuable insight into ground conditions, physical access routes and heritage sensitivities in advance of a potential drilling program.

The CuFe delegation included experienced geological consultant Hilke Dalstra, who has played a leading role in a number of significant discoveries in his 30 year career at Rio Tinto, including most recently the Winu copper deposit in Western Australia. Hilke won the Rio Tinto Discovery Award on three occasions as well as the AMEC (Australia) Prospectors award, PDAC (Canada) Thayer Lindsey Award, and the SEG Silver Medal.

The fieldwork was supervised by Ngururrpa Traditional Owners, building on the working relationship following the execution of a Land Access Agreement with the Parna Ngururrpa (Aboriginal Corporation) RNTBC in 2024.

CuFe Executive Director Mark Hancock commented "It's exciting for us to have completed our first on-ground work in the West Arunta region. This region has been the scene of several significant discoveries in recent years so, having invested the time required to achieve access, it was pleasing to see the team on the ground building our knowledge and relationships. We were fortunate to secure Hilke Dalstra to join the CuFe team on the trip. Hilke has been involved in a number of significant discoveries, including Winu copper, so it will be valuable to have his insights on our project.

We would like to thank the Ngururrpa Traditional Owners for welcoming us to their Country and the team at Central Desert Native Title Services for facilitating the arrangements.

We would also like to acknowledge our neighbours in the region, Encounter Resources for providing us with logistical support and accommodation at their camp.”

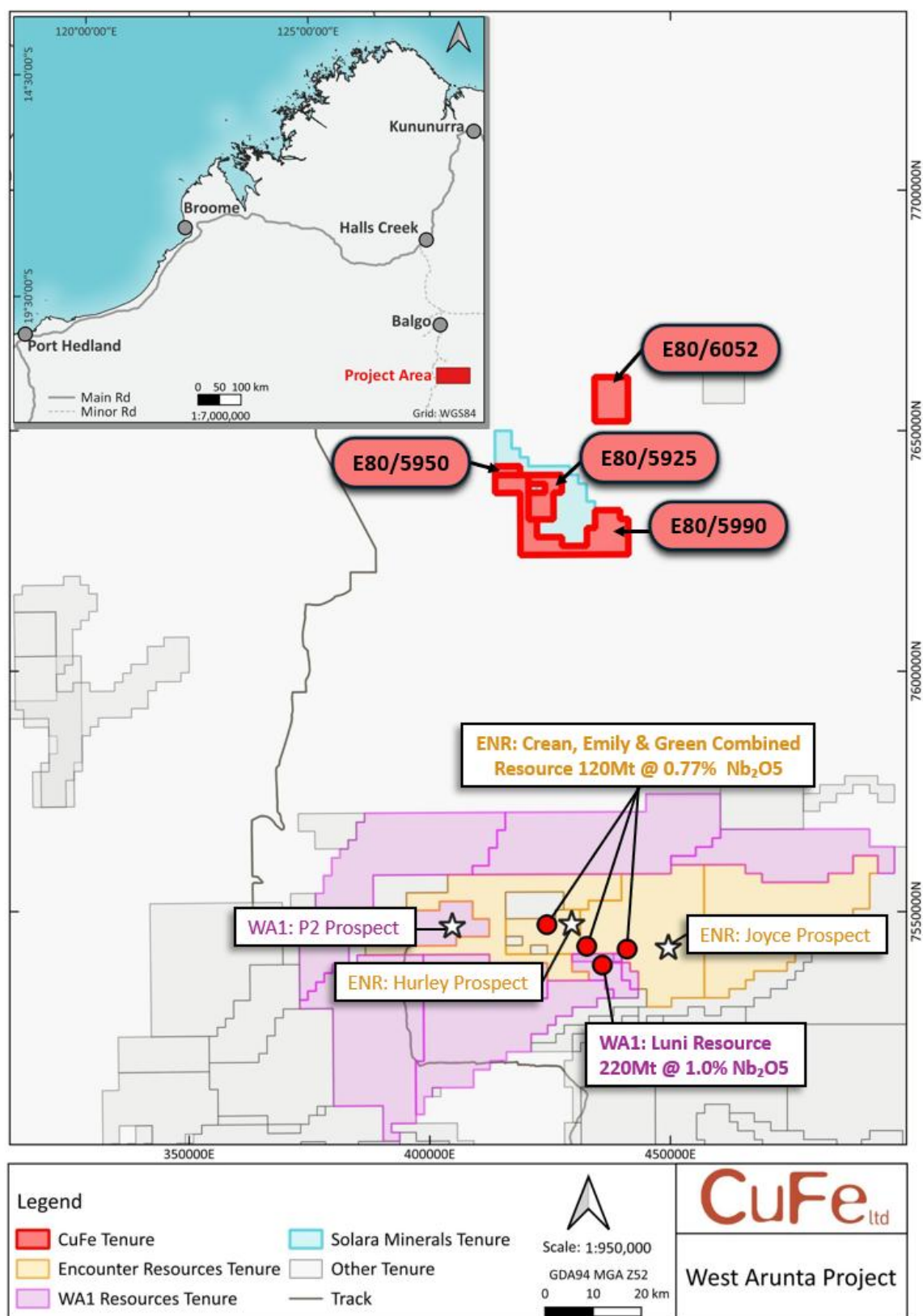


Figure 1 – West Arunta locality map and CuFe tenure.

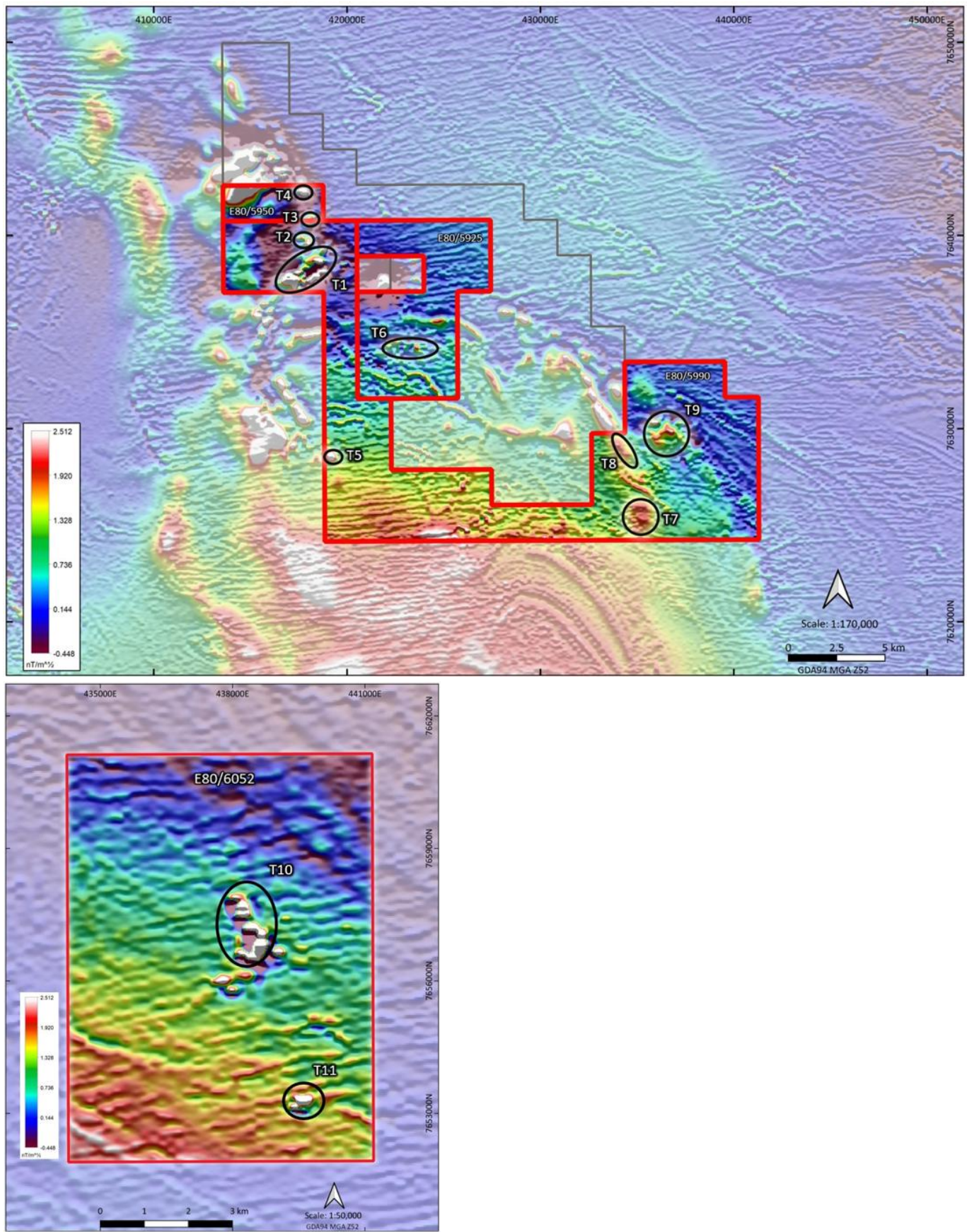
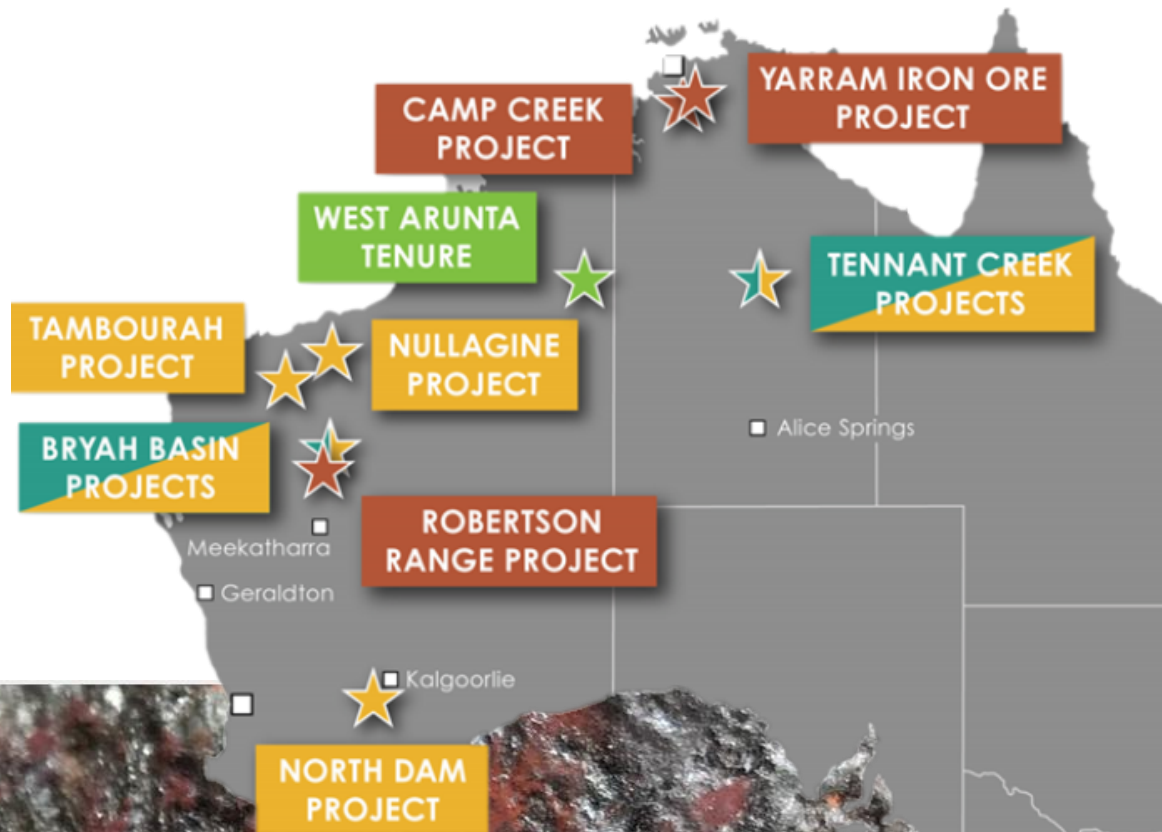


Figure 2 – CuFe Targets and aeromagnetic imagery (TMI).
