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June 2026 Quarterly Production Update

Emerald Resources NL (ASX: EMR) ("**Emerald**" or "**Company**") advises that the Company's 100% owned Okvau Gold Mine in Cambodia ("**Okvau**") produced circa 27Koz of gold during the June 2026 Quarter.

Highlights

Okvau Gold Mine Operations, Cambodia (EMR 100%)

- June 2026 Quarter Gold Production and AISC guidance;
 - Okvau gold production for the June 2026 Quarter of ~27Koz within ongoing quarterly guidance of 25Koz - 30Koz;
 - Indicative AISC for the June 2026 Quarter is anticipated to be at the lower end of guidance ~US\$880/oz;
- Financial Year 2026 Gold Production and AISC guidance;
 - Okvau gold production for the Financial Year 2026 of ~100Koz below financial year guidance of 105Koz - 120Koz given lower production quarters early in the financial year;
 - Indicative AISC for the Financial Year 2026 is anticipated to be in line with guidance ~US\$966/oz;
- Cash, bullion and listed investments on hand as at 26 June 2026 of A\$468M (US\$322M).

While Financial Year 2026 gold production of approximately 100Koz was below guidance primarily due to lower production during the early part of the financial year, the Okvau Gold Mine performance improved over the second half with the final two quarters delivering within ongoing quarterly guidance of 25Koz – 30Koz. As a result, AISC for these two quarters were at the lower end of guidance with full year AISC expected to remain in line with guidance of US\$966/oz.

Emerald remains fully funded, debt free and unhedged and is on track to achieve its strategic objective of becoming a multi-mine gold producer exceeding 300Kozs per annum. This growth will be driven by key developments, including the underground expansion, pit extensions and near-mine prospects at the 100% owned Okvau Gold Mine, development of a second standalone operation in Cambodia at the 100% owned Memot Gold Project and development of Emerald's first Australian operation at the 100% owned Dingo Range Gold Project.

A comprehensive update of operations and exploration activities will be provided in the June 2026 Quarterly Report to be released later this month.
