1. RESOLUTION 1 – CONSOLIDATION OF CAPITAL

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass, with or without amendment, the following resolution as an **ordinary resolution**:

"That, pursuant to section 254H of the Corporations Act and for all other purposes, Shareholders approve the consolidation of the issued capital of the Company on the basis that:

- (a) every 10 Shares be consolidated into 1 Share;*
- (b) every 10 Options be consolidated into 1 Option;*
- (c) every 10 Performance Rights be consolidated into 1 Performance Right,*
with fractional entitlements rounded down to the nearest whole Security."

2. RESOLUTION 2 – CHANGE OF COMPANY NAME

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as a **special resolution**:

"That, for the purposes of section 157(1)(a) of the Corporations Act and for all other purposes, approval is given for the name of the Company to be changed to Antimony Resources Limited."

Voting by proxy

In accordance with section 249L of the Corporations Act, Shareholders are advised that:

- each Shareholder has a right to appoint a proxy;
- the proxy need not be a Shareholder of the Company; and
- a Shareholder who is entitled to cast two or more votes may appoint two proxies and may specify the proportion or number of votes each proxy is appointed to exercise. If the Shareholder appoints two proxies and the appointment does not specify the proportion or number of the member's votes, then in accordance with section 249X(3) of the Corporations Act, each proxy may exercise one-half of the votes.

Shareholders and their proxies should be aware that:

- if proxy holders vote, they must cast all directed proxies as directed; and
- any directed proxies which are not voted will automatically default to the Chair, who must vote the proxies as directed.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Explanatory Statement has been prepared to provide information which the Directors believe to be material to Shareholders in deciding whether or not to pass the Resolutions.

1. RESOLUTION 1 – CONSOLIDATION OF CAPITAL

1.1 Background

On 20 July 2026, the Company announced that it will be undertaking a consolidation of the Company's issued capital on a 10:1 basis (**Consolidation**), subject to Shareholder approval (**Announcement**).

In the same announcement, the Company also announced that it will be undertaking a partially underwritten pro-rata non-renounceable entitlement offer of one (1) Share for every ten (10) Shares held by eligible shareholders on the record date at an issue price of \$0.005 per Share, together with one (1) free attaching Option for every one (1) Share subscribed for and issued, exercisable at \$0.0075 on or before 31 August 2030, to raise up to approximately \$1,520,002 (before costs) (**Offer**).

The issue of Securities pursuant to the Offer will not be subject to Shareholder approval as they will not take up the Company's available placement capacity due to the operation of Listing Rule 7.2 (Exception 1).

For the avoidance of doubt, any Shares issued as part of the Offer after the date of consolidation, including any shortfall securities, will be issued on a post-consolidation basis.

Please refer to the Announcement for further information.

1.2 General

This Resolution seeks Shareholder approval for the purposes of section 254H of the Corporations Act and all other purposes to consolidate the Company's issued capital on a 10:1 basis.

1.3 Legal requirements

Section 254H of the Corporations Act provides that a company may, by resolution passed in a general meeting, convert all or any of its shares into a larger or smaller number.

Listing Rule 7.20 provides that if an entity proposes to reorganise its capital, it must tell shareholders of each of the following:

- (a) the effect of the proposal on the number of securities and the amount unpaid (if any) of the securities;
- (b) the proposed treatment of any fractional entitlements arising from the reorganisation; and
- (c) the proposed treatment of any convertible securities on issue.

Listing Rule 7.21 provides that an entity which has convertible securities (except options) on issue may only reorganise its capital if, in respect of the convertible securities, the number of securities or the conversion price, or both, is reorganised so that the holder of the convertible securities will not receive a benefit that holders of ordinary securities do not receive.

Listing Rule 7.22 provides that where an entity with options on issue undertakes a consolidation of its issued capital, the number of options must be consolidated in the same ratio as the ordinary capital and the exercise price must be amended in inverse proportion to that ratio.

1.4 Effect on capital structure

The effect the Consolidation will have on the Company's capital structure is set out in the table below.

1.7 Holding statements

1.8 Taxation

It is not considered that any taxation implications will exist for security holders arising from the Consolidation. However, security holders are advised to seek their own tax advice on the effect of the Consolidation and neither the Company, nor its advisers, accept any responsibility for the individual taxation implications arising from the Consolidation.

2. RESOLUTION 2 – CHANGE OF COMPANY NAME

Section 157(1)(a) of the Corporations Act provides that a company may change its name if the company passes a special resolution adopting a new name.

This Resolution seeks the approval of Shareholders for the Company to change its name to "Antimony Resources Limited".

The Board proposes this change of name on the basis that it believes the proposed name more accurately reflects the future operations of the Company.

The proposed name has been reserved by the Company with ASIC and if this Resolution is passed, the Company will lodge a copy of the special resolution with ASIC following the Meeting in order to effect the change. If this Resolution is passed the change of name will take effect when ASIC alters the details of the Company's registration.
