QUARTERLY ACTIVITY STATEMENT FOR QUARTER ENDED 30 SEPTEMBER 2025

The Directors are pleased to present the Quarterly Activities Statement for Energy World Corporation Limited and its consolidated entities (“EWC” or “**the Company**”) for the quarter ended 30 September 2025 (“**the Period**”). The accompanying Appendix 4C should be read in conjunction with this statement.

During the Period, the Company’s focus remained on its core projects in the Philippines and Indonesia, and on progressing the sale of non-core assets in Australia.

Considerable effort and expenditure were directed towards the various due diligence processes required to advance both the investment-bank-led capital raising and the proposed debt-to-equity conversion.

These initiatives culminated in the release to market on 17 October 2025 of a substantial document containing the Notice of Meeting and supporting materials, including an Independent Expert’s Report with a detailed technical review of EWC’s projects in the Philippines and Indonesia.

Included within item 1.2(f) “Administration and Corporate Costs” of US\$2.9 million are payments of approximately US\$0.42 million to external advisors for the preparation of various independent reports, including Technical Due Diligence, the Independent Expert’s Report, and tax advice.

Item 6.1 of the Appendix 4C disclosed payment to related parties of US\$0.15 million. It relates to director’s salary and director’s fee paid.

There were no substantive revenue-generating business activities during the quarter. Sales of Australian property assets realised net proceeds of US\$88,142 after costs.
