NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Notice is given that the Annual General Meeting of Freedom Care Group Holdings Limited ("the Company") will be held at the Hall Chadwick, Level 40, 2 Park Street, Sydney, Australia at 9.00am (AEST) on Wednesday, 2 September 2026. The attached Explanatory Memorandum should be read in conjunction with the Notice of Annual General Meeting.

ORDINARY BUSINESS

Item 1 Financial Statements and Reports

To receive and consider the Statement of Financial Position of the Company at 30 June 2025, the Income Statement of the Company for the year ended on that date, together with the consolidated accounts of the Company and its controlled entities and the reports of Directors and Auditors therein.

Resolution 1: Adoption of Remuneration Report

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass the following resolution:

"To adopt the remuneration report forming part of the Directors' Report for the financial year ended 30 June 2025."

(Note: The vote on this Resolution 1 is advisory only and does not bind the Directors or the Company.)

Voting Restriction

As required by Section 250R of the Corporations Act, the Company will disregard any votes cast on Resolution 1 by key management personnel and any closely related party of any key management personnel as those terms are defined in section 9 of the Corporations Act 2001. However, the Company need not disregard a vote if:

- it is cast by a person as a proxy for a person who is entitled to vote, in accordance with the directions on the proxy form; or
- it is cast by a person chairing the meeting as proxy for a person who is entitled to vote, in accordance with a direction on the proxy form to vote as the proxy decides; or
- it is cast by a person chairing the meeting as proxy for a person who is entitled to vote, in accordance with the chair's stated voting intention as outlined in the explanatory memorandum.

Resolution 2: Re-election of a Director

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as an ordinary resolution:

"In accordance with the constitution of the Company, Ms Ola El Helu who, being a director of the Company, retires by rotation and being eligible, is re-elected as a Director of Freedom Care Group Holdings Limited."

The Chair of the AGM intends to vote all available proxies in favour of Resolution 2.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Explanatory Memorandum has been prepared for the information of shareholders of Freedom Care Group Holdings Limited (“Freedom Care” or “the Company”) in connection with the business to be transacted at the Annual General Meeting of shareholders of the Company to be held at Hall Chadwick, Level 40, 2 Park Street, Sydney, Australia at 9.00am (AEST) on Wednesday, 2 September 2026.

The Directors recommend shareholders read the accompanying Notice of Annual General Meeting (“Notice”) and this Explanatory Memorandum in full before making any decision in relation to the resolutions.

ITEM 1: Financial Statements

In accordance with the Constitution, the business of the Annual General Meeting will include receipt and consideration of the annual financial report of the Company for the financial year ended 30 June 2025 together with the declaration of the directors, the directors’ report, the remuneration report and the auditor’s report.

In accordance with amendments to the Corporations Act, the Company is no longer required to provide a hard copy of the Company’s annual financial report to Shareholders unless a Shareholder has specifically elected to receive a printed copy.

Whilst the Company will not provide a hard copy of the Company’s annual financial report unless specifically requested to do so, Shareholders may view the Company’s annual financial report on its website at www.freedomcaregroup.com.au

Resolution 1: Adoption of Remuneration Report

The Corporations Act requires that at a listed company’s Annual General Meeting, a resolution that the remuneration report be adopted must be put to Shareholders. However, such a resolution is advisory only and does not bind the Directors or the Company. The remuneration report sets out the Company’s remuneration arrangements for the Directors and senior management of the Company. The remuneration report is part of the Directors’ report contained in the annual financial report of the Company for the financial year ended 30 June 2025. A reasonable opportunity will be provided for discussion of the remuneration report at the Annual General Meeting.

Resolution 2: Re-election of a Director

The Constitution provides that at every annual general meeting, one third of the Directors must retire from office by rotation and are eligible for re-election. Ms Ola El Helu retires by rotation and is seeking re-election. Ola El Helu is an accomplished and dynamic consultant with a passion for healthcare and a deep expertise in radiology operations management. With over 20 years of experience in the field, Ola has demonstrated exceptional leadership and exemplifies a perfect blend of technical expertise, leadership acumen, and a genuine commitment to patient well-being.

Ola has held roles in both the public and private healthcare sectors in Australia and overseas, along with a global health company, GE Healthcare. In recent years, Ola has been involved in numerous start-up companies in which she was instrumental in transforming radiology greenfield practices into efficient and cutting-edge facilities by streamlining workflows, optimizing resource allocation, and implementing state-of-the-art technologies to enhance diagnostic accuracy and patient outcomes. TO VOTE BY COMPLETING THE PROXY FORM

STEP 1 APPOINTMENT OF PROXY

Indicate who you want to appoint as your Proxy.

If you wish to appoint the Chair of the Meeting as your proxy, mark the box. If you wish to appoint someone other than the Chair of the Meeting as your proxy please write the full name of that individual or body corporate. If you leave this section blank, or your named proxy does not attend the meeting, the Chair of the Meeting will be your proxy. A proxy need not be a securityholder of the company. Do not write the name of the issuer company or the registered securityholder in the space.

Appointment of a Second Proxy

You are entitled to appoint up to two proxies to attend the meeting and vote. If you wish to appoint a second proxy, an additional Proxy Form may be obtained by contacting the company's securities registry or you may copy this form.

To appoint a second proxy you must:

- (a) complete two Proxy Forms. On each Proxy Form state the percentage of your voting rights or the number of securities applicable to that form. If the appointments do not specify the percentage or number of votes that each proxy may exercise, each proxy may exercise half your votes. Fractions of votes will be disregarded.
- (b) return both forms together in the same envelope.

STEP 2 VOTING DIRECTIONS TO YOUR PROXY

To direct your proxy how to vote, mark one of the boxes opposite each item of business. All your securities will be voted in accordance with such a direction unless you indicate only a portion of securities are to be voted on any item by inserting the percentage or number that you wish to vote in the appropriate box or boxes. If you do not mark any of the boxes on a given item, your proxy may vote as he or she chooses. If you mark more than one box on an item for all your securities your vote on that item will be invalid.

Proxy which is a Body Corporate

Where a body corporate is appointed as your proxy, the representative of that body corporate attending the meeting must have provided an "Appointment of Corporate Representative" prior to admission. An Appointment of Corporate Representative form can be obtained from the company's securities registry.

STEP 3 SIGN THE FORM

The form **must** be signed as follows:

Individual: This form is to be signed by the securityholder.

Joint Holding: where the holding is in more than one name, all the securityholders should sign.

Power of Attorney: to sign under a Power of Attorney, you must have already lodged it with the registry. Alternatively, attach a certified photocopy of the Power of Attorney to this form when you return it.

Companies: this form must be signed by a Director jointly with either another Director or a Company Secretary. Where the company has a Sole Director who is also the Sole Company Secretary, this form should be signed by that person. **Please indicate the office held by signing in the appropriate place.**

STEP 4 LODGEMENT

Proxy forms (and any Power of Attorney under which it is signed) must be received no later than 48 hours before the commencement of the meeting therefore by **before 9:00am (AEST) on Monday, 31st August 2026.** Any Proxy Form received after that time will not be valid for the scheduled meeting.
