In the Company's view, any equity raising may (i) have involved an unattractive discount and (ii) not have been underwritten and so involve a degree of uncertainty. Accordingly, the Convertible Notes, under which financial accommodation is being provided by existing Shareholders, was considered to be preferable to an equity raising because of the certainty of the commitment of funds and the fact that the most likely scenario involves conversion at the current market price, meaning that dilution is minimised as the Noteholders will not receive the benefit of conversion at a discount. The Convertible Notes are superior to 'pure' debt because they are mandatorily convertible into Share upon drawdown under the Project Financing. This will assist the Company to comply with its obligations under the Project Financing and effectively eliminates the risk of cross-default beyond that point. In addition, 'pure' debt for bridging finance in connection with a project such as the Project would be more expensive for the Company than the Convertible Notes.
