DRILLING COMMENCES AT PAYNES FIND GOLD PROJECT

Oakajee Corporation Ltd (“**Oakajee**” or “**the Company**”) is pleased to advise that Aircore (AC) drilling has commenced at the Paynes Find Gold Project in Western Australia.

A total of 28 drill holes for about 1500m drilling is planned to follow up previously intersected gold at the Paynes Find South target (ASX Announcement 19 February 2024).

The AC drilling program is expected to take approximately one week to complete. Analytical results are expected to be reported late in the December Quarter.

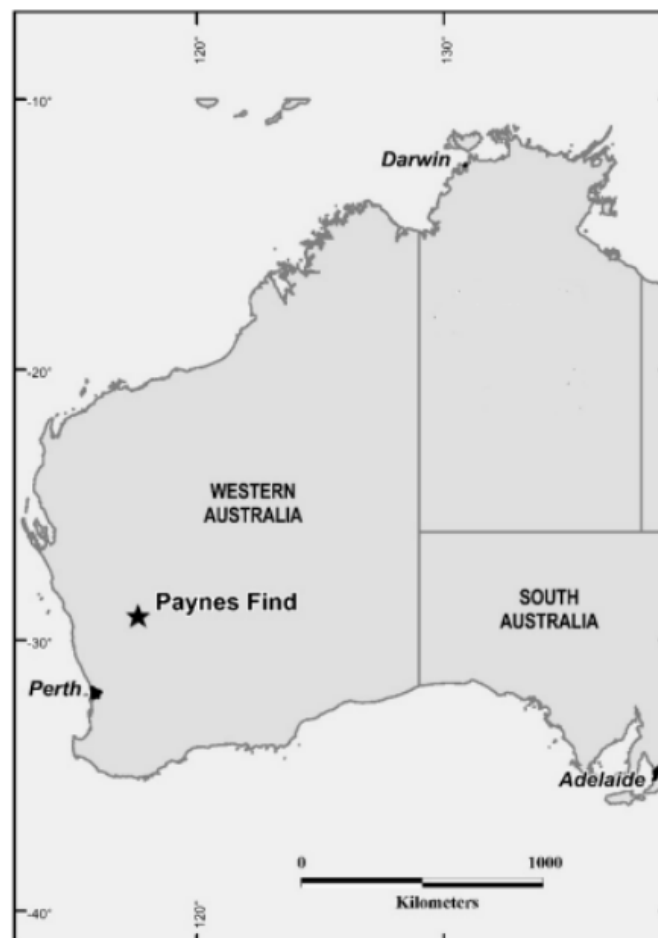


Figure 1 - Paynes Find Gold Project location

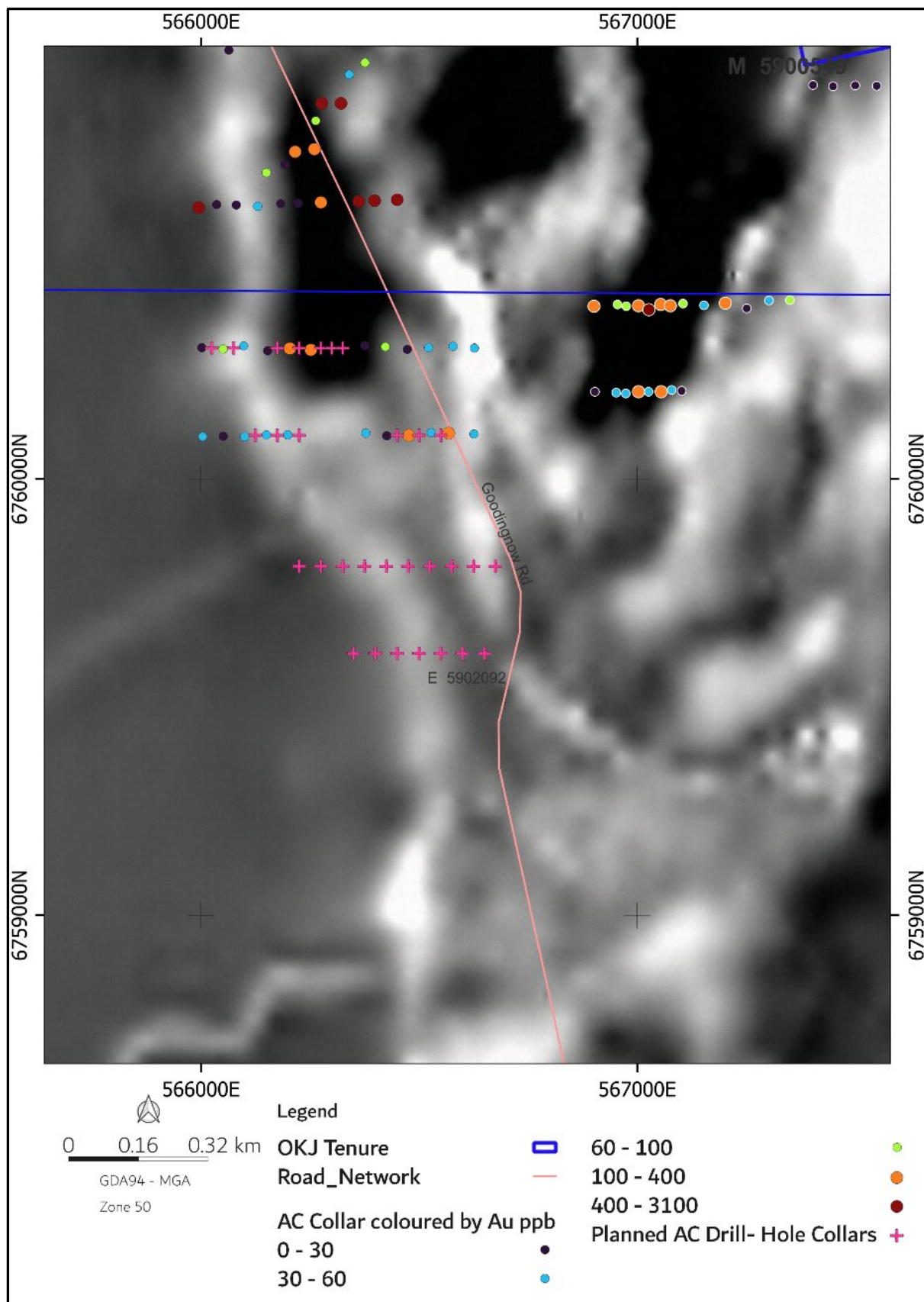


Figure 2: Air-core drill-hole collars coloured by Au ppb and planned AC collar positions over aero magnetic image.

About The Paynes Find Gold Project

The Paynes Find Gold Project is located adjacent to the Paynes Find settlement, approximately 455km by road northeast of Perth. The tenements cover parts of the Paynes Find Greenstone Belt to the south and west of the main gold camp with reported historic production of more than 72,000oz of gold.

OKJ has completed several phases of AC drilling to test the South Paynes Find target. The most recent in November 2023 (ASX Announcement 19 February 2024). This drilling intersected anomalous gold results of >0.1g/t Au with associated pathfinder elements, Bi, As, Co, Cu, W (Figure 2). These results are interpreted as a weathering dispersion halo from a near-by but not yet intersected bedrock source. The gold mineralisation trend is open to the south under shallow alluvial cover associated with similar trending structures evident in the magnetic image (Figure 2). The current planned drilling will both infill and extend the known target area.
