Update on response to cyber incident

24 October 2025 – ReadyTech Holdings Limited (ASX:RDY) (**ReadyTech** or **Company**) refers to its announcement on 17 October 2025 regarding a cyber incident involving its hosted student management system, VETtrak (**Platform**).

The Company has today become aware that a cybercriminal has published a small number of documents containing personal information, originating from the Platform.

In line with government guidance, the Company urges that no one tries to access the post or the data, which only feeds the business model of cybercriminals and may be a criminal offence.

The Company is responding to this recent development and is taking appropriate steps. The Company has updated the Australian National Office of Cyber Security as well as other relevant government agencies.

Given the criminal nature of this incident, the Company has briefed the Australian Federal Police. The Company will continue to support all efforts by these agencies as their investigations continue.

The Company will today notify the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner and the New Zealand Office of Privacy Commissioner. In addition, ReadyTech will seek to notify affected individuals of steps they can take to prevent misuse.

The full extent of customer information that has been accessed and the total number of customers impacted remains under investigation.

We will continue to keep our customers and stakeholders updated as our wider investigation continues.
