CHANGE OF AUDITOR

RemSense Technologies Limited (**ASX: REM**) ("**RemSense**" or the "**Company**") advises that HLB Mann Judd (**HLB**) have been appointed as the Company's auditor. The appointment follows the resignation of BDO Audit Pty Ltd (**BDO**) and ASIC's consent to BDO's resignation in accordance with section 329(5) of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) (**the Act**).

The Board's decision to change auditors follows a review of the Company's external audit requirements, taking into account audit quality, service capability, audit fee structure and alignment with the Company's operational needs. The Board thanks BDO and its partners for their services over the past 5 years since the Company listed on ASX.

The Board undertook a tender and consultation process, during which several qualified audit firms were evaluated. Following this assessment, HLB were selected based on their depth of experience with ASX listed entities, demonstrated audit capability and alignment with the Company's operational requirements.

In accordance with section 327C of the Act, a resolution will be put to shareholders at the 2026 Annual General Meeting to ratify the appointment of HLB as the Company's Auditor.
