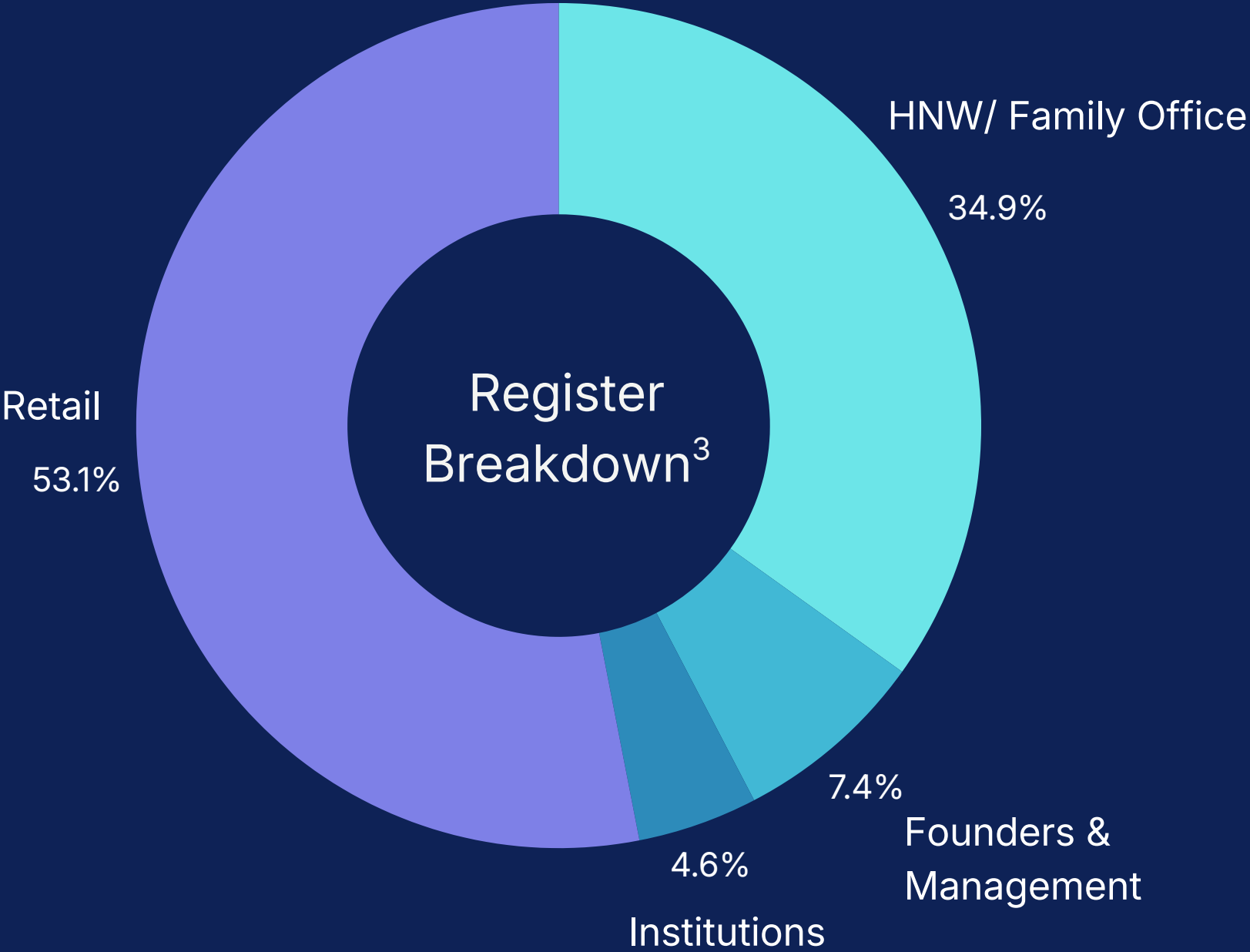
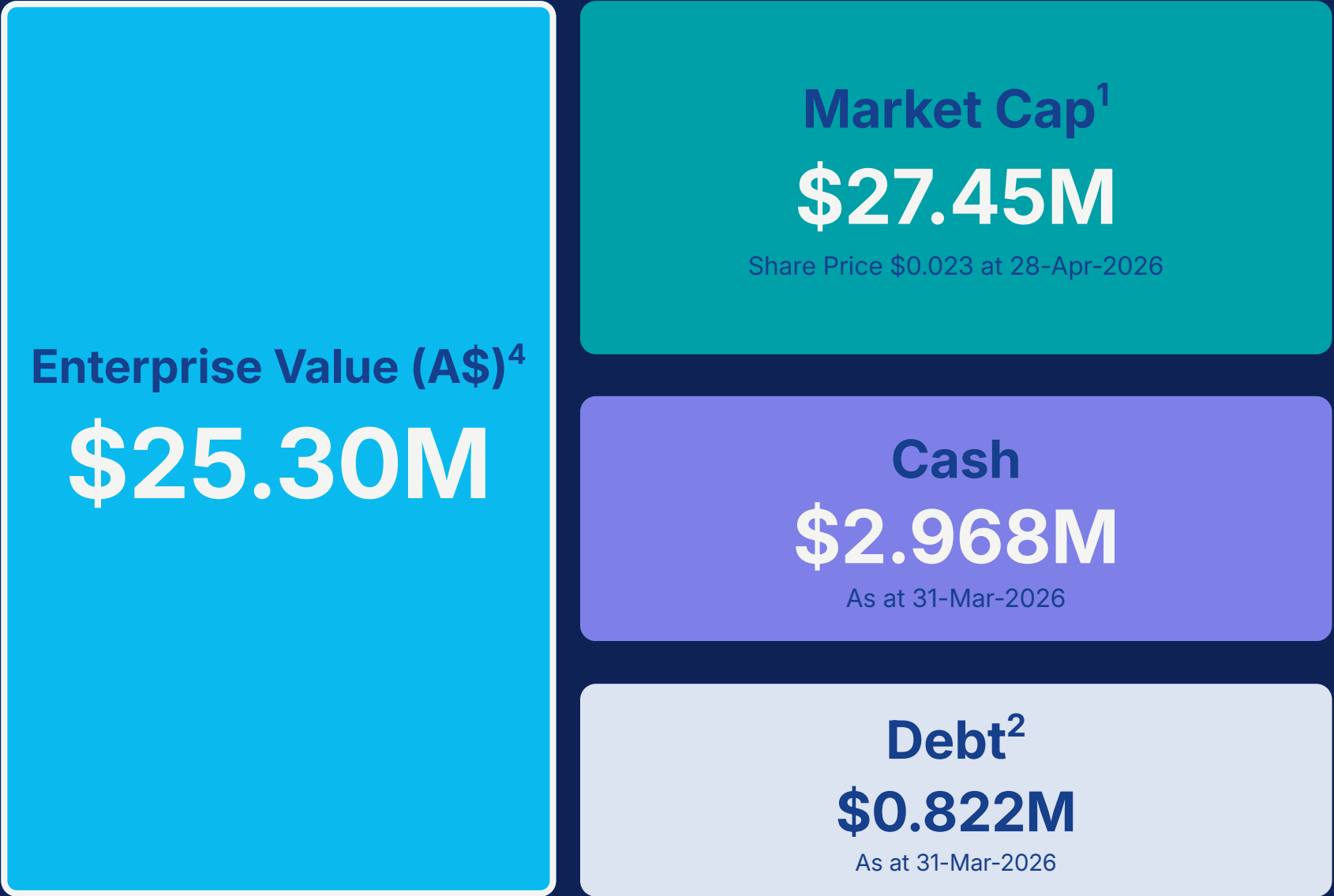

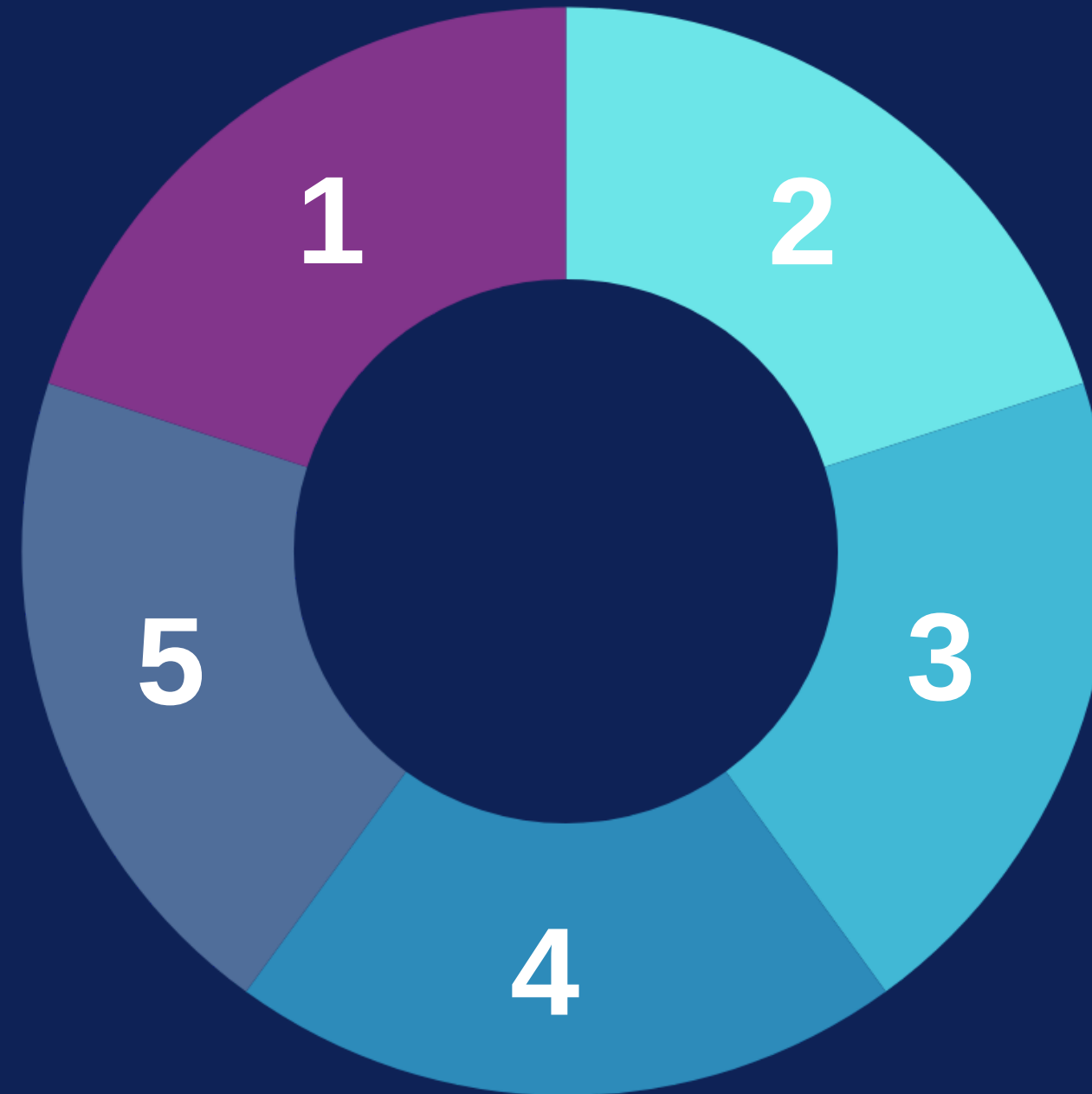

A Perfect Storm of Critical Issues



Operational Complexity

As high-grade ore-bodies are exhausted, miners are moving into remote and geologically complex regions. Majority of processing plants at capacity, placing higher emphasis on ore recovery technologies



Lagging Innovation Investment

A fifth of all Mining companies surveyed are expected to spend 20%+ of additional budget on building AI capabilities over the next 12-months, while 34% will spend 5 – 19% more, maximizing the digital transformation within their operations



Rising Costs & Productivity

Due to skills crisis, wages remain elevated while productivity is declining. High royalties and trade tariffs intensify cost pressures, with miners seeking technological solutions to improve productivity.

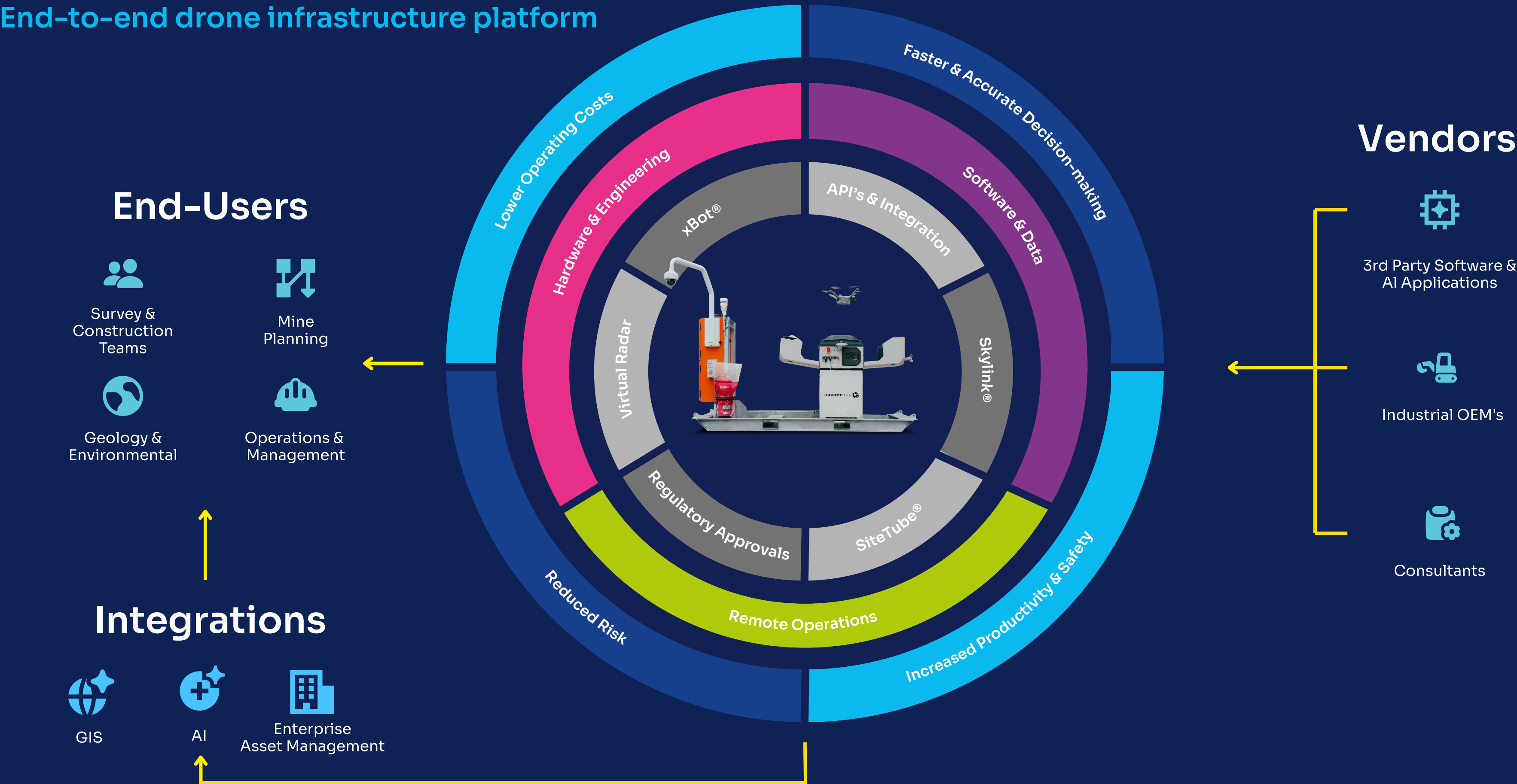


Workforce Constraints

Persistent perception challenges limit the industry's ability to attract, retain, and recruit younger workers. Mental health-related challenges also inhibit the industry's ability to attract, recruit, and retain skilled workers, particularly FIFO work, which involves long working hours, physical strain and isolation.

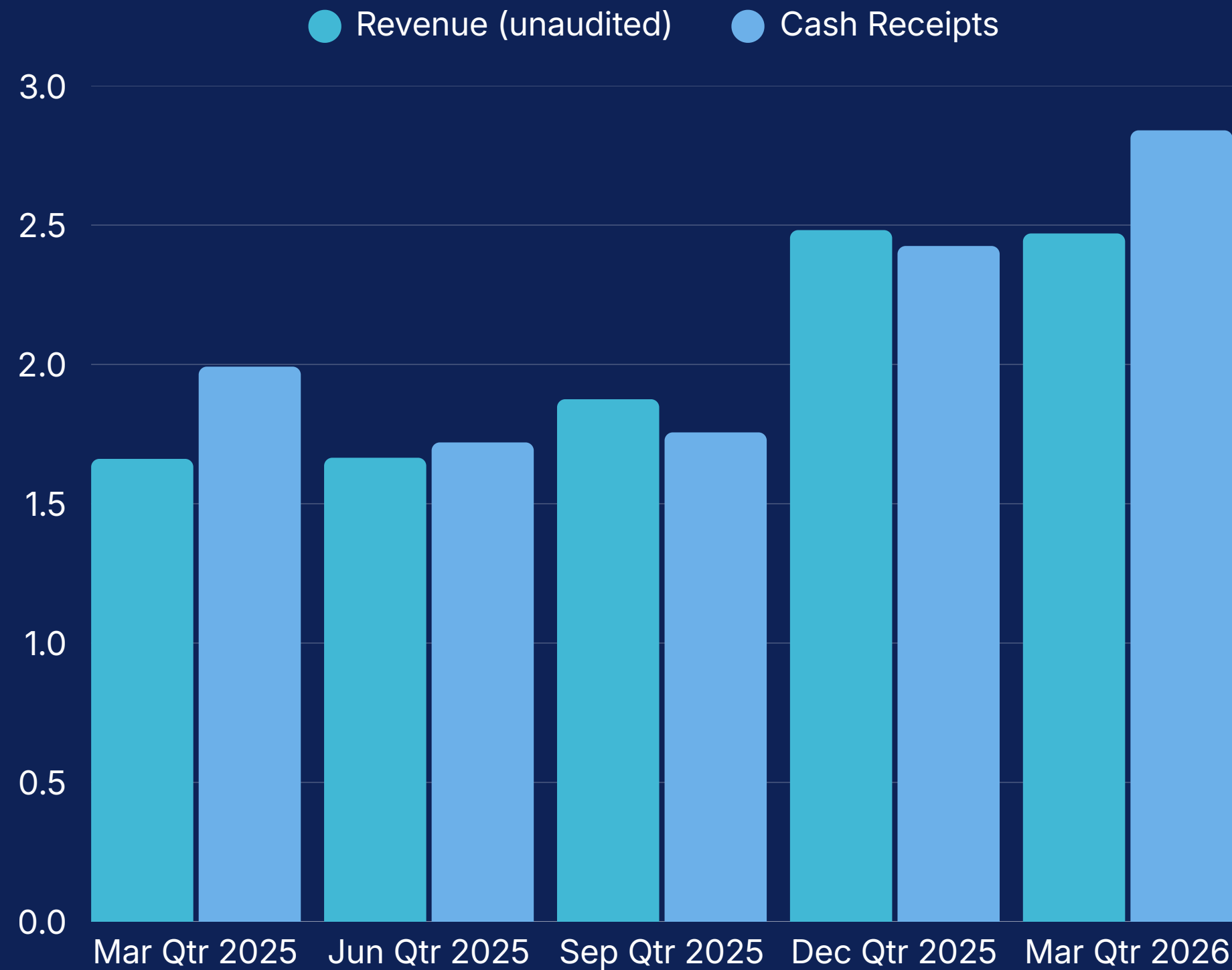
- **Scheduled Missions:** Automated, recurring flights deliver data when and where needed – enabling consistent data delivery for reliable reporting

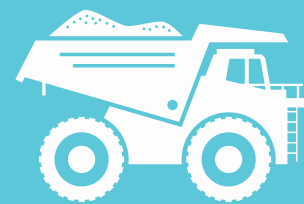

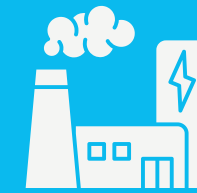

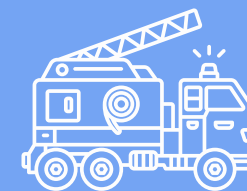
