

Rox signs Native Title Mining Agreement for Youanmi Gold Mine

Rox Resources Limited ("**Rox**" or "**the Company**") (**ASX:RXL**) is pleased to advise it has signed a Native Title Mining Agreement with the Badimia Barna Native Title Claim Applicant in relation to the Company's Youanmi Gold Mine in Western Australia.

- **Binding Mining Agreement executed with the Badimia Barna Native Title Claim Applicant covering the Youanmi Gold Mine project area**
- **Agreement provides consent for the grant and renewal of future mining tenure as well as conduct of mining activities within the project area**
- **Establishes a long-term framework for heritage protection, employment, training and business development opportunities for Badimia people**
- **Agreement represents a key project milestone as Rox advances development of the Youanmi Gold Mine**

A Native Title Mining Agreement ("**Agreement**") has been entered into by Rox Resources Limited and its wholly owned subsidiary Rox (Murchison) Pty Ltd with the authorised representatives of the Badimia Barna Native Title Claim Applicant (WAD 258/2024).

The Agreement provides the consent of the Badimia Barna Native Title Claim Applicant for the grant and renewal of all future project tenements, and all future approvals required for project, mining and exploration activities across the Company's tenements. Rox's existing project tenure and future applications within the defined project area are covered by the Agreement.

The Agreement also establishes a framework for ongoing cooperation between the parties in relation to heritage protection, environmental consultation, employment, training and contracting opportunities.

For Rox, the Agreement reflects a shared commitment to the responsible development of the Youanmi Gold Mine and provides a foundation for a long-term and constructive relationship with the Badimia people.

Managing Director & CEO Mr Phill Wilding commented:

"The signing of this Agreement is an important milestone for the Youanmi Gold Mine and reflects the positive relationship that has been developed between the Rox team and the Badimia people."

"We are committed to working collaboratively with the Badimia people to ensure cultural heritage is respected and that the benefits generated by Youanmi are shared through employment, training and business development initiatives."

Badimia traditional owners thanked Rox for their respectful approach throughout the negotiations. In particular the acknowledgement of the importance of cultural heritage by a mining company was refreshing. Their proactive support of Badimia artists and programs to engage young people are also very much appreciated.

Native Title Mining Agreement

The Agreement includes:

- Consent for the grant and renewal of project tenure and associated mining approvals.
- A framework for cultural heritage management and cultural awareness initiatives.
- Employment, training and contracting opportunities for Badimia people and businesses.
- Establishment of a project liaison committee to support ongoing engagement between the parties.
- A package of financial benefits including an upfront payment plus a production-based royalty.

The completion of the Agreement represents another important step in the advancement of the Youanmi Gold Mine as Rox continues to progress towards delivering gold in mid-CY2027.
